To help support our population of hedgehogs in Landkey you can do the following things:

- *Check before strimming – injuries to hedgehogs are horrific

- *Leave out a shallow bowl of water

- *Only feed with cat/dog or hedgehog food – no peanuts, milk, bread or mealworms/calciworms

- *Any hedgehog seen during the day who is "sunbathing" or walking lethargically please rescue. Wearing gloves place in a high sided box on top of towels with hot water bottle underneath. Don't feed or give water until you call Barney Hogs on 07398 495124 or Littlest Wildlife Hotel 07481 801447

Landkey Millennium Green

Thanks to an award from the Heritage Lottery the Millennium Green will see improvements over the next year. The leaking container, where equipment is stored, will be repaired. Potentially dangerous woodland trees will be removed, enabling some new planting of shrubs and bulbs to make the area more attractive to wildlife (and humans). The area of meadow, important for pollinating insects, will benefit from a new mechanical scythe, and we'll do clearance work on the silted-up old leat. All will be explained on new notices, particularly in an improved picnic area. Volunteers work hard to keep the Green looking good for all. However, there are still unavoidable running costs, (for example grass cutting tractor and other equipment, dog bin emptying, insurance), so thanks to all who donate. Particular thanks to all involved in the MAY PLANT SALE in the VillageHall which contributed over £300 to the Green funds.
